Included in the tournament guide is a schedule of MGA tournaments, meetings and special events. Also included are a list of general rules and procedures for MGA tournament play. The rules and procedures were established to create standards for MGA tournament play that are fair and equitable for all handicap levels. The type of tournaments and formats for the year 2010 are based on past successes. There are a few new tournament formats this year. This was done to “spice things up” some and provide new challenges. However the favorite formats are all still in place.

My hope is that the variety of formats will generate interest for those of you who have chosen not to participate in the past. There will be individual play, pick your partner play, as well as golf shop pairings giving you, the member, a chance to play with new people and develop new friendships.

Tournament formats, activities, and procedures are subject to change – tournament dates are firm (at this point based on WCCC management approval).

MGA Tournament Rules - 2010

General rules for all MGA tournament plan unless otherwise detailed in the specified tournament rule sheet.

USGA Rules apply except for the following:

1. Must be a member of the MGA to be eligible for MGA tournaments.
2. 14 club rule waived unless otherwise stated.
3. The ball is to be played down in individual and best ball events.
4. Handicaps for all tournaments will be based on USGA guidelines where applicable: Individual – 100%, Best Ball – 80%, Match Play – 80%, Scramble – 50%, and Shamble – 50%.
5. Improved lies will be played in all scramble events.
6. Putts inside a standard grip length will be given in all scramble events otherwise you must hole all putts. In match play competition your competitor may give putts.
7. All play will be from the Tournament Tees (Blue if not present) unless otherwise stated in specific event schedule.
8. All ties for net will be broken by scorecard play-off starting with the number one handicap hole, then the number two handicap hole and so-forth until the tie is broken. Ties for gross will be by last nine holes, six holes... per USGA recommendations.
9. There will not be a one ball rule - when playing improved lies you may change balls otherwise you may only change when putting or in between holes as USGA procedures provide.
10. When playing improved lies the following will apply:
 - You may improve your lie one **grip length** no closer to the hole.
 - You can not improve from rough to fairway or on to the green when off the green.
 - You may improve position within the one standard grip length.(i.e. move from behind a tree, no closer to the hole)
 - You can not improve your lie in a hazard. In a partnership, the original ball must be played as it lies and the other ball(s) must be placed as close to the original position as possible.
11. All equipment must conform to USGA rules.
12. The goal for all tournaments will be to have 10 to 12 teams/individuals in each flight. However, at no time should a flight have less than 9 teams/individuals per flight. Any adjustments to flights that are required should be done within the “first and last flights” to balance the fields.
13. Pay outs within each flight will be approx 60 % and 40% respectively for first and second net and gross. Gross will take precedence on ties
14. The maximum number of players in any event is 120 players. If the tournament is a 4-man format, the maximum number of teams is 30; a 2-man format the maximum number of teams is 60, etc.
15. Sign up deadlines for tournaments is by 5 p.m. two days prior to the tournament. Preferred method is to use the MGA Website. Example: a tournament that begins on Saturday, the sign up deadline will be the Thursday prior to the tournament. A Sunday only tournament the deadline will be the 5 p.m. the Friday prior.
16. All tournament entry fees will be charged through your Walnut Creek Club account. Cash will only be accepted for “Day Money” fees; when “Day Money” is part of the tournament.
17. Any changes to the above rules must be approved by the by the Tournament Chairman **prior** to the beginning of any tournament. All tournament rulings / decisions will be made by tournament committee and shall be final.
18. Tournament Committee will be composed of the MGA Board Members and WCCC Director of Golf or Head Professional.
19. MGA Board has the right to adjust tournament handicaps based on previous tournament scorecards of repeat winners..
20. Maximum 10 stroke handicap difference between players for all non individual tournaments. Higher handicaps will be reduced to the 10 stroke difference.

- ✚ **Course:** Pecan – 9 holes

- ✚ **Start:** Shotgun start

- ✚ **Entry Fee:** \$20.00 per player

- ✚ **Payout:** 1st and 2nd Gross for Scramble formats and 1st and 2nd net for Shamble formats.

- ✚ **Team:** Golf Shop Pairing

- ✚ **Format:** Four man scramble or shamble as listed above. Scramble format will use one ball gross score only and Shamble will use two balls, net score only. Each team must use a minimum of one drive per player.

- ✚ **Flights:** The tournament will be flighted by total team handicap, divided into to two flights – upper and lower total team handicap.

- ✚ **Tees:** All play will be from the blue tees

- ✚ **Rules:** MGA / USGA rules apply

- ✚ **Handicaps:** No handicaps used for scramble and 50% used for shamble.

- ✚ **Activities:** WCCC Ballroom - MGA meeting following tournament with meal & beverages.

- ✚ **Reminder:** Tournament and meeting worth 20 points toward TOP 50

MGA Frostbite Open

Three Man Scramble, Shamble, and Best Ball

- 🚩 **Date:** Saturday – January 17th
- 🚩 **Course:** Pecan
- 🚩 **Time:** 12:30 p.m. Shotgun with meeting at 11:00 am, Breakfast Buffet @ 9:30 am.
- 🚩 **Entry Fee:** \$40.00 per player
- 🚩 **Payout:** 1st and 2nd Net and Gross within each flight.
- 🚩 **Team:** Pick your own team or Golf Shop Pairing
- 🚩 **Format:** Three-man event – the golf course will be divided into three 6-hole events (per scorecard not where you start)- holes 1-6 will be Scratch/Medal Play, holes 7-12 will be Scramble, and holes 13-18 will be Shamble. Scratch/Medal Play – One net best ball. Scramble – straight scramble, select the best shot and all players play from that position. Shamble- all payers tee off and select the best drive. After the best drive is selected each player continues play with their own ball from that position. After each player holes out their golf ball; the best net ball per team will be used.
- 🚩 **Flights:** Flighted by total team handicap – minimum of 9 teams and maximum 12 teams per flight if at all possible. No senior flight due to limited number of teams.
- 🚩 **Tees:** Tournament tees (Blue if tournament tees not out)
- 🚩 **Rules:** MGA / USGA rules apply
 - Scratch – Ball is to be played down.
 - Shamble - Improve your lie one grip length after selecting the drive, except in hazards, then each player plays his ball down until his ball is holed out.
 - Scramble – Improve your lie one grip length through the green.
- 🚩 **Handicaps:** Scratch – 80% of handicap.
 - Shamble - 50% of individual's handicap will be used.
 - Scramble – 20% of total team handicap.
 - The cards will be dotted and strokes given where they fall for each of the six holes.
- 🚩 **Activities:** Breakfast buffet and coffee prior to tournament with beer, soft drinks, and tea after the tournament.
- 🚩 **Reminder:** This tournament/meeting is worth 30 points towards TOP 50 events.














MGA - Red, White, and Blue

Two Man Best Ball














- + Date:** Saturday – February 27th
- + Course:** Oak
- + Time:** 12:30 p.m. Shotgun
- + Entry Fee:** \$40.00 per player
- + Payout:** 1st and 2nd Net and Gross within each flight.
- + Team:** Pick your own team or Golf Shop Pairing
- + Format:** Two-man event - Golfers will play the red tees starting on hole 1, then the white on hole 2, and then the blue on hole 3. You will keep alternating in that order (red, white, and blue) through the 18 holes. After each player holes out their golf ball the best net ball and best gross ball will be recorded by each team.
- + Flights:** Flighted by total team handicap - Minimum of 10 teams and maximum 12 teams per flight if at all possible.
- + Tees:** Red, White, and Blue tees
- + Rules:** MGA / USGA rules apply
- + Handicaps:** 80% of handicap based on the white tee handicap for the Oak Course. The cards will be dotted and strokes given where they fall for each of the six holes.
- + Activities:** Lunch before shotgun, beer, and beverages served after the round in the Pavilion. Scoring will be in Pavilion.
- + Reminder:** Tournament is worth 20 points toward TOP 50

Individual Stroke Play

-  **Date:** Saturday & Sunday – March 13th & 14th
-  **Course:** Pecan
-  **Time:** 10:00 a.m. – Tee Times on Saturday
8:30 a.m. – Shotgun Sunday
-  **Entry Fee:** \$40.00 per player
-  **Payout:** 1st and 2nd Net and Gross within each flight.
-  **Team:** Individual
-  **Format:** 36 holes selection tournament - Each player will play 18 holes each day. The net & gross best ball for each hole from the two rounds will be counted for a single net & gross 18 hole score. Example: If on hole #1 of Saturday's round you score a net par but on Sunday you score a net birdie then the net birdie will count towards your 18 hole total.
-  **Flights:** Flighted by handicap – 10 to 12 teams per flight depending number of teams signed up. Senior flight (must be over 60 years of age and minimum handicap of 8) will be open assuming a minimum of 6 players declared and eligible.
-  **Tees:** All flights except senior flight will play from the blue tees.
-  **Rules:** MGA / USGA rules apply with the following exceptions:
-  **Handicaps:** 100% of handicap.
-  **Activities:** Sunday - lunch, beer and beverages served after the round in Pavilion. Scoring in Pavilion both days.
-  **Reminder:** Tournament is worth 20 points toward TOP 50

MGA Two Man Best Ball

-  **Date:** Saturday & Sunday – April 24th & 25th
-  **Course:** Oak
-  **Time:** 8:30 a.m. – Shotgun Both Days
-  **Entry Fee:** \$40.00 per player
-  **Payout:** 1st and 2nd Net and Gross within each flight.
-  **Team:** Pick your own team / Golf Shop Pairing
-  **Format:** Best ball format – low net and gross score from the team is selected for each hole.
-  **Flights:** Flighted by total team handicap – 10 to 12 teams per flight depending number of teams signed up.
-  **Tees:** All play will be from the blue tees.
-  **Rules:** MGA / USGA rules apply with the following exceptions:
-  **Handicaps:** 80% of handicap.
-  **Activities:** Saturday - Lunch, beer and beverages served after the round in the Pavilion. Scoring in Pavilion both days.
-  **Reminder:** Tournament is worth 20 points toward TOP 50

-  **Date:** Saturday, May 8th
-  **Course:** Pecan
-  **Time:** 12:30 p.m. - Shotgun
-  **Entry Fee:** \$40.00 per player
-  **Payout:** 1st and 2nd Net and Gross within each flight.
-  **Team:** Member & One Guest (not WCCC golf member)
-  **Format:** Front 9 (holes 1-9) 9 hole shamble and back nine (holes 10-18) best ball. After each player completes play of the hole record best net and gross scores.
-  **Flights:** Flighted by team handicap – 10 to 12 teams per flight depending number of teams signed up.
-  **Tees:** All play will be from the blue tees.
-  **Rules:** MGA / USGA rules apply with the following exceptions:
-  **Handicaps:** 100% of handicap.
-  **Activities:** Lunch before shotgun, beer, and beverages served after the round in the Pavilion. Scoring in the Pavilion.
-  **Reminder:** Tournament is worth 20 points toward TOP 50

- + Date:** Friday, May 21st
- + Course:** Oak
- + Time:** 8:30 a.m. & 1:30 p.m. - Shotgun
- + Entry Fee:** \$40.00 per player for one or both tournaments
- + Payout:** 1st and 2nd Net and Gross within each flight prorated based on entries for each tournament.
- + Team:** Pick your foursomes morning and shop pair afternoon.
- + Format:** Morning individual play – record net and gross scores.
- + Format:** Afternoon 4-man waltz starting on hole 1 – 1 ball on hole 1, 2 balls on hole 2, three balls on hole 3 and starts over on hole 4 (1,2,3...) through the 18 holes. After each player completes play of the hole record individual gross scores and total net and total gross scores for each hole.
- + Flights:** Flighted by team handicap – 10 to 12 teams per flight depending number of teams signed up.
- + Tees:** All play will be from the blue tees.
- + Rules:** MGA / USGA rules apply.
- + Handicaps:** 100% of handicap for morning individual play and 70% for afternoon Waltz.
- + Activities:** Lunch and beverages served after the first round in the Pavilion. Beer, and beverages served in Pavilion after second round. Scoring in Pavilion after both rounds.
- + Reminder:** Each Tournament is worth 20 points toward TOP 50.

- Date:** Saturday & Sunday, June 5th & 6th
- Course:** Oak Saturday / Pecan Sunday
- Time:** 8:30 a.m. – Shotgun both days
- Entry Fee:** \$40.00 per player for one or both tournaments
- Payout:** 1st and 2nd Net and Gross within each flight.
- Team:** Pick your own team / Golf Shop Pairing
- Format:** Saturday – front nine (holes 1-9) Best Ball and back nine (holes 10-18) Scramble. Record one ball for scramble (50% of team total will be deducted from 9 hole score. Record one best net and gross ball for best ball play.
- Format:** Sunday - front nine (holes 1-9) Shamble and back nine (holes 10-18) Individual total. Record one best net ball and gross ball for shamble and combined total (both balls) net and gross for individual total format.
- Flights:** Flighted by team handicap – 10 to 12 teams per flight depending number of teams signed up.
- Tees:** All play will be from the blue tees.
- Rules:** MGA / USGA rules apply.
- Handicaps:** 50% of handicap used for Scramble and Shamble, 80% for Best Ball, and 100% for Individual Total formats. Because formats are nine hole 50% of you handicap will used for calculating nine hole handicap – if you are a 10 handicap you will get 5 strokes as a starting point, shamble & scramble (50% of 5), Best Ball (80% of 5) and Individual Total (100% of 5).
- Activities:** Saturday - lunch and beverages served before round in the Pavilion. Sunday - beer, and beverages served after second round in the Pavilion.
- Reminder:** Tournament is worth 20 points toward TOP 50.

MGA & RMGA Ryder Cup - Top 50

-  **Date:** Friday, July 9th – Sunday, July 11th
-  **Course:** Pecan
-  **Time:** 5:30 p.m. Friday, 8:30 a.m. Saturday and Sunday
-  **Entry Fee:** \$50.00 per player
-  **Team: MGA –** Top 50, top points on points list as of June 17th (Includes Thursday Meeting) ties will be broken by drawing. RMGA and MGA captains will pick 25 two man teams for each days matches. Teams from RMGA and MGA will be numbered 1 through 25 from lowest to highest handicap, team numbers will play each other for each daily match. Captains have the option to modify up to 5 teams per day and additionally 5 teams for final nine holes on Sunday.
-  **Format:** All matches will be worth 1 point (½ point for ties). All teams will have a total of 5 matches – total of 125 points. Winner will be awarded the Ryder Cup to be displayed in men’s locker room and will fly his flag for the next year. All participants will be given tee prize with special award for champions.
-  **Format:** Friday – Nine hole scramble – (50% handicap). Shotgun start, teams 1-13 will play back nine and teams 14 – 25 will play front nine.
-  **Format:** Saturday – Nine hole best ball (80%) – Nine hole combined total (100%). Shotgun start for first nine hole match with teams 1-13 starting on the front side and teams 14-25 starting on the back nine. S After first nine matches the teams will reverse nines for combined total..
-  **Format:** Sunday – Nine hole Schamble (50%) - Nine hole alternate shot (80%). Shotgun start, teams 1-13 will start on back nine and teams 14 -25 will start on front nine. After first nine matches the teams will reverse nines for alternate shot.
-  **Flights:** 25 two man teams based on captains pick and ordered by handicap.
-  **Tees:** MGA will play blue tees and RMGA will play white tees.
-  **Rules:** USGA / WCCC local rules apply with the following exceptions: No
-  **Handicaps:** As defined above for each nine event.
-  **Activities:** Friday – Food in pavilion after the round
Saturday – Lunch after conclusion of play
Sunday – Lunch and Ice Cream Bar after conclusion of play.

-  **Entry Fee:** \$40.00 per player
-  **Payout:** 1st and 2nd Net and Gross within each flight.
-  **Team:** Pick your own team or Golf Shop pairing.
-  **Format:** Two Man 36 holes selection tournament -each player will play 18 holes each day. Two net and two gross scores for each hole will count for a total of 36 holes for the two days. One player can count his score for a particular hole for the two days. Example: on the first day player A scores a 4 on hole 1 and player B scores a 5, on the second day player A scores a 3 and player B scores a 4. The team can count Player A's score for the two days for a combined total of 7 on hole 1. Each team will have a net and gross combined score for each hole.
-  **Flights:** Flighted by handicap – 10 to 12 teams per flight.
-  **Tees:** All flights except senior flight will play from the blue tees.
-  **Rules:** MGA / USGA rules apply.
-  **Handicaps:** 80% of handicap.

-  **Entry Fee:** \$40.00 per player for one or both tournaments
-  **Payout:** 1st and 2nd Net and Gross within each flight prorated based on entries for each tournament.
-  **Team:** Golf shop pairing
-  **Format:** 5-man shamble counting three low net balls. Must use two driver per player.
-  **Flights:** Flighted by team handicap – 10 to 12 teams per flight depending number of teams signed up.
-  **Tees:** All play will be from the blue tees.
-  **Rules:** MGA / USGA rules apply.
